You will learn about the main aspects to be addressed in the agreements:

- **Technical** reservoir estimates, partitioning, depletion strategy, other (non-)communicating reservoirs
- **Economical** gas marketing, taxation treaty, project economics, abandonment provisions
- **Commercial** cross border issues, market potential, depletion or supply type contracting, FID
- **Legal** applicable laws and legislation, lifting and balancing agreements, evacuation agreements

What are the potential pitfalls to be taken into account in the contractual negotiations between licenseees?
